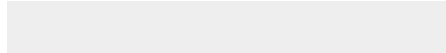
What AFP has Done for Me Lately!

WHAT'S YOUR ETHICS IQ?

Everyone who belongs to AFP must sign and abide by the AFP Code of Ethical Principles and Standards, but what does that really mean in practice? As a benefit of your AFP membership, you can take the Ethics Assessment Inventory™ (EAI), a research-based ethics assessment tool which focuses on six characteristics of ethical fundraising practice. This 14-item online survey instrument provides both fundraisers and their organizations a snapshot of their ethical performance, a comparison of themselves with peers from across AFP, and a way to assess and strengthen ethical dimensions of their practice. This member benefit, which is strictly voluntary and available online, was developed on the basis that the best ethical decisions are made when there is alignment among the individual moral compass of fundraising professionals, the principles and standards of the profession as a whole and the values of the organization where fundraising professionals work.
